## HILTON PHUKET ARCADIA HOTEL & RESORT

STAR Classification: ★★★★★

333 Patak Road, Karon Beach Muang, Phuket, Thailand



In the heart of the Karon hotel strip, this property is superior to and certainly bigger than most other hotels along the beach. The former Phuket Arcadia Hotel & Resort underwent a full renovation that refurbished guest rooms and public areas to bring it up to Hilton standards; even the Thai royal family has vacationed here. Just across the road from the long beach, this attractive grouping of curvaceous high-rises is cleverly interconnected with breezy walkways winding around cool reflecting pools. The main 12-story wing contains reception desk, restaurants, a lagoon pool, deluxe rooms, and studios, and Phuket's largest and most inviting conference facilities.

The subdued open-air lobby is done in mosaic tile, and the lounge, set under a large glass awning, shows bright floral fabrics, hardwood furniture and traditional Thai accents. A

chic coffee shop supplements a modern Thai restaurant and casual Euro-Asian buffet dining room. It would be a shame to visit Thailand and not indulge in the delicious and spicy food served in the signature Thai restaurant called *Thai, Thai*. For another Asian experience, *Bangles* near the beach serves spicier food from India. *Caffe Cino* brings the cafe society to the beaches of Phuket. There are two bars for pre- and post-dinner drinks.

Upgraded recreational facilities include three pools (including a calming waterfall and waterslides for the kids), watersports desk, squash and tennis courts, a putting green, game room, gym, sauna and massage facilities. A spa with 15 new private villas showcases traditional Thai design in its private treatment rooms. The nearby public beach rents umbrellas for bargain rates, and massages are available for more affordable prices than at the spa but certainly not of the high professional standards of the spa. A lifeguard supervises ocean bathers. The conference rooms accommodate 1,500 delegates in cocktail seating and include an extensive range of business amenities.

The large superior and deluxe guest rooms are among the best on the island, done in earthy tones and appointed with exposed timber or tile floors. Standard features include roomy sitting areas, comfortable lounges with brightly-colored pillows, minibars, cable TV, IDD phones, high-speed Internet access, one king or two queen beds, and mostly waterview balconies. New beds incorporate the chain's well-known pillow-top mattresses and fine linens. The well-designed baths have a large glass window onto the bedroom but with a burgundy and gold privacy blind emblazoned with Thai motifs, built-in dressing tables, branded toiletries, robes, slippers, bottled water and hair dryers. Deluxe rooms in the Lotus Wing have cozy raised lounges, while the preferable rooms called Studios, offer spacious baths with stall showers. The refurbished Deluxe rooms are the most exciting and offer sleek Thai design touches, DVD players and polished floors that reflect. A crisp duvet tops the bed. Premium rooms enjoy access to the resort's executive lounge for breakfast, all-day drinks and evening snacks.

One floor is dedicated smoke-free, and baby-sitting can be arranged. Room service operates all day and night. The staff is very professional.

This group-oriented hotel may not be the best choice for individuals, but it does not intimidate them. Repeat guests are recognized and welcomed with open arms. Far from the crowds, this hotel is of equal caliber to the Kata Thani and certainly up there with the best in terms of facilities offered.
